Loganville Borough Mayor's Report – August 2022

**Issues/Concerns/Requests:** none

### Mayor Report Summary:

- Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Report: none received
- District Court Reports: none received
- Emergency Management (EM):
  - Fire Police Requests: none received
  - Weather Emergencies: York County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) provided numerous National Weather Service (NWS) Weather Briefings and a Heat Wave Notification throughout the month which were passed to Borough Council (BC). In addition, the following incident occurred during the month:
    - 5857 – July 2<sup>nd</sup>: Category: Adverse / Severe Weather; Event Type: Severe Thunderstorms / Lighting Strike; County: York County; Jurisdiction: \*County Wide\*
  - EM Coordinator (EMC): A request from York County OEM for a 2023 Special Event Data Call was received on July 19<sup>th</sup> with a due date of Tuesday, August 26<sup>th</sup>. With the borough having no special events over the last two years, I will submit a “negative report” indicating that the borough is not scheduled to have any such events in 2023.
  - Meetings/Training: York County OEM Quarterly EMC Training was held at the Department of Emergency Services, 120 Davies Drive, York on Wednesday, July 13<sup>th</sup> from 6:30-9:00 PM. Topics for the quarterly training included:
    - Threat Assessment, George Giangli, Chair, South Central Pennsylvania Task Force ((SCTF) [www.SCTFPA.org](http://www.SCTFPA.org))
    - Damage Assessment, Shen Kreiser, York County OEM
    - New Freedom missing person incident on June 29<sup>th</sup>, Stan Walters, South Central York County EM Agency (EMA)
    - Pennsylvania EMA (PEMA) D2022-02, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Emergency Management Certification Program effective, July 5, 2022 rescinding PEMA D2017-02, Rob Pena, PEMA

The topics of most relevance were Damage Assessment and PEMA certification. I should be able to complete all of my certification requirements by the end of 2022.

- Correspondence: A letter documenting completion of mowing on a property that had only been partially mowed was mailed July 8<sup>th</sup> and received on July 11<sup>th</sup>. This should deter future such issues with this property owner. Three Ordinance Violation Letters were mailed on 27 July, per Ordinance 2006-2 with Revision 2009-1 (Grass and Weeds Excessive Height). None have yet been signed for and none of the properties have been mowed.
