## Loganville Borough Mayor's Report – September 2022

**Issues/Concerns/Requests:** none

### Mayor Report Summary:

- Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Report: none received
- District Court Reports: none received
- Emergency Management (EM):
  - Fire Police Requests: none received
  - Weather Emergencies: York County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) provided four National Weather Service (NWS) Weather Briefings throughout the month which were passed to Borough Council (BC).
    - EM Coordinator (EMC):
      - A response to the York County OEM 2023 Special Event Data Call request received on July 1<sup>9th</sup> was submitted on August 15<sup>th</sup>. As reported last month, with the borough having no special events over the last two years, I submitted a “negative report” indicating that the borough is not scheduled to have any such events in 2023.
      - On August 10<sup>th</sup>, the Deputy Director of York County OEM sent out an email regarding Loganville Borough and Springfield Township EM Agencies (EMAs) and the status of the 2003 Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement (ICA) between the two municipalities. A follow-on email from Springfield Township stated that the municipality’s board and council will be working to rectify the situation.
      - At 5:28 am on August 25<sup>th</sup>, I notified BC of the I-83 detour at the South Queen Street exit due to a second bridge collision that was reported by York County OEM at 10:14 pm the previous night.

- Meetings/Training:
  - York County OEM held a “meet and greet session” for EMCs, Municipalities, and First Responders at York County Fairgrounds on August 17<sup>th</sup> from 4-8pm, which I attended. It was a good opportunity to engage with other EMCs and learn more about some of the 15 Emergency Support Functions (ESFs).
  - I completed the G235, *Emergency Planning* course which was held at York County OEM on August 27-28.
  - After I complete the G271, *Hazardous Weather and Flooding Preparedness* course on October 18-19, I will have completed all of the Pennsylvania requirements for permanent local EM certification.
- Correspondence: The three Ordinance Violation Letters (Grass and Weeds Excessive Height) covered in the August report were all received and corrective action was taken by the property owners during the month of August.

Miscellaneous:

- By the end of August, five properties were very close to needing Ordinance Violation Letters (Grass and Weeds Excessive Height). By the time I return to Loganville, I may have to send two such letters.
- By Presidential proclamation on September 8, I lowered Loganville's U.S. flag, which is to remain at half-staff until sunset on the day of interment, to honor and mourn Queen Elizabeth II. Queen Elizabeth passed away on September 8, 2022, at the age of 96.
