## Loganville Borough Mayor's Report – May 2025

### Issues/Concerns/Requests: none

#### Mayor Report Summary:

- Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Report: none received
- District Court Reports: none received
- Emergency Management (EM):
  - Fire Police Requests: none received
  - Weather Emergencies:
    - The York County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) provided numerous National Weather Service weather briefings throughout the month, none of which were significant enough to pass to Borough Council (BC).
- Meetings/Training:
  - I participated in York County OEM's 2025 Spring All-Hazards Table Top Exercise (TTX) on Tuesday, April 22 from 9:00 AM-12:00 PM. TTX discussions revealed that Hazardous Materials (HAZMAT) incidents may be a greater threat than many realize due to the ever increasing volume of tractor trailer traffic on I-83, as well as HAZMAT transit via rail and pipelines throughout York County.
- Correspondence:
  - As briefly discussed at the last BC meeting, due to the inability to completely match a vehicle with a property owner for an ordinance violation during the Snow Emergency Declaration for Winter Storms Harlow and Iliana, a retraction letter was provided to the resident last month. The resident was appreciative and also understands that the Warning Letter they received during the winter of 2023-2024 still remains on file with the Borough.

- Miscellaneous: With the spring mowing season upon us, I've begun identifying and addressing properties that need mowing. Two commercial property owners have been contacted, one of which should mow this week, whereas the other is still pending. There are also a few residential properties which will be addressed next week as well.
