Loganville Borough Mayor's Report – November 2024

- Correspondence:
 - On Tuesday, October 8, York County Office of EM (OEM) sent out an email from the York County Planning Commission (YCPC) to EM Coordinators (EMCs) announcing that the 2024 York County Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) had been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) pending adoption by York County and its 72 municipalities (1st attachment). The York County Commissioners are expected to adopt the HMP on November 6, after which the county's municipalities will be notified. The next step is for Loganville Borough and the other 71 municipalities to adopt the HMP via a resolution to be submitted to the YCPC for filing with Pennsylvania EMA (PEMA) and FEMA. YCPC provided a SAMPLE Adoption Resolution (2nd attachment) in PDF and Microsoft (MS) Word format. I pre-populated the MS Word version with Loganville Borough information (3rd attachment).

- Correspondence: (cont.)
 - On Thursday, October 31, York County OEM sent out an email containing the York County Board of Commissioners County Burn Ban (4th attachment), in effect for 30 days as of October 30, 2024. Borough Council was notified and it was subsequently sent to Loganville residents via Savvy Citizen and posted on the borough webpage.

- Miscellaneous:
 - After being contacted by a resident about a non-functioning street light on the west side of North Main Street (18 North Main Street, Pole No. 2927-19230), I submitted a report via the Met Ed/FirstEnergy web site https://firstenergycorp.com/service_requests/report-lighting-problem.html on Thursday, August 22 to report it. The street light (FirstEnergy Lighting Request W001762447725) was repaired on or about Thursday, October 14, 2024.
