Loganville Borough Mayor's Report – August 2021

Issues/Concerns/Requests:

- On Tuesday, June 1st, the York County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) informed EM Coordinators (EMCs) that they are officially closing the COVID-19 incident. They also indicated that the Disaster Declaration (county) will remain in place for the time being. Additionally, they asked us to confirm whether we will continue to maintain our Disaster Declaration or terminate it, and inform them of our decision. *Pending confirmation from our Solicitor, I recommend that we terminate our Declaration, unless retaining it is necessary for any pending funding requests*

- On Monday, July 5th a young man from Aptive Environmental Pest Control www.AptivePestExterminator.com stopped by my residence to solicit. After requesting his permit and producing none, I informed him that he was in violation of the borough's solicitation ordinance (2014-03) and as Mayor one of my principal duties is Law Enforcement (LE). I encouraged him to depart the borough so I wouldn't need to perform LE duties. I notified Borough Council (BC) of his activities after he departed.

Mayor Report Summary:

- Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Report: none received
- District Court Reports: none received
- Emergency Management (EM):
 - Fire Police Requests: none received
 - Weather Emergencies: York County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) provided multiple National Weather Service (NWS) weather briefs, including Tropical Storm Elsa. The NWS Advisories were provided to BC after receipt.
 - EM Coordinator (EMC): On July 21st, I received the enclosed York County Board of Commissioners Press Release, *2021 West Nile Virus Mosquito Samples Collected in West Manchester and Carroll Townships*.

- Meetings/Training:
 - York County OEM conducted Quarterly EMC Training at the Department of Emergency Services, 120 Davies Drive, York, to be held on Wednesday, July 7th from 6:30-9:00 pm. The training was some Local EMCs providing their perspectives and experiences with Regionalization of EM Agencies (EMAs).
 - On July 16th, York County OEM informed EMCs of the 2021 Community Exercise, which will be held on Wednesday, September 14, 2021 from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm during National Preparedness Month. It is intended to provide a scenario for a community-wide exercise which allows participating organizations to test their own emergency plans in a way that meets their needs. This will be similar to the All Hazards Exercise which was held on April 22nd. The exercise registration deadline is August 31st.
- Correspondence:
 - On Wednesday, July 21st, I issued an Ordinance Violation letter to a resident for violations of Borough Ordinances 1974-53, 2006-02 (with Revision 2009-01) and 2013-01 for vehicles, vegetation and nuisances. Because there are repeat offenses, fines are being levied.
