Loganville Borough Mayor's Report – June 2021

Issues/Concerns/Requests:

- On June 1st, the York County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) informed EM Coordinators (EMCs) that they are officially closing the COVID-19 incident. They also indicated that the Disaster Declaration (county) will remain in place for the time being. Additionally, they asked us to confirm whether we will continue to maintain our Disaster Declaration or terminate it, and inform them of our decision. I recommend that we consider terminating our Declaration, unless retaining it is necessary for any pending funding requests.

Mayor Report Summary:

- Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Report: CPL James Spencer, from the PSP York Station appeared at the May Loganville Borough Council (BC) Meeting and rendered his report, as LT Spingler, the Station Commander had forecasted. There were no significant issues reported. Some BC Members expressed concerns over excessive speeds on main streets in the borough, especially by tractor trailers.
- District Court Reports: none received
- Emergency Management (EM):
 - Fire Police Requests: On May 26th, I received a request from the Springfield Township Board of Supervisors dated May 12, 2021 (enclosure) requesting approval for Loganville Borough Fire Police to support two Jacobus Lions Club, Inc. events (4th of Jul Blast and Cancer Crushin' 5K (August 22nd)), which I recommend we approve.
 - Weather Emergencies: York County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) provided a National Weather Service (NWS) Severe Thunderstorm/Weather Advisories on May 25th and 26th. The NWS advisories were provided to BC after receipt.
 - EM Coordinator (EMC): See Issues/Concerns/Requests, above.
- Meetings/Training:
 - The After Action Report (AAR) for the April 22nd York County OEM 2021 Spring All-Hazards Exercise, which I hoped to complete by the end of May, is incomplete. The new AAR target completion date is the end of June.

- Meetings/Training (continued):
 - York County OEM conducted Quarterly EMC Training at the Department of Emergency Services, 120 Davies Drive, York on Wednesday, May 12th from 6:30-9:00 pm. Following awards presentations, during which I received my Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency Basic Certification credential, the training topic was *Effective Relationships with Township and Borough Officials*. Some key takeaways:
 - From 2010-2019, York County's overall population increased 2.5-5%, compared to the statewide increase of only +0.8%. The Jacobus, Loganville, Springfield Township region has increased over 5%.
 - There are 3 Fire Service problems: funding, volunteers and organizational issues.
 - The 2020 value of a volunteer in Pennsylvania is \$26.67/hour, a 5% increase from 2019.
 - A digital copy of the briefing is available to BC members upon request.
 - Correspondence: On Wednesday, May 19th, I signed a courtesy warning letter to a Loganville establishment citing Borough Ordinance 2006-02 with Revision 2009-01, *Excessive Vegetation Height*, because the establishment failed to mow all of their property. We are still awaiting a response.
 - Miscellaneous: N/A
