Dear Loganville Borough Residents,

Service for Loganville Borough is 1 cart for recycling and 1 cart for trash. All residents were originally given a 65-gallon recycling cart and 95-gallon trash cart. There is also an option for a 35-gallon trash cart for residents who don't generate as much trash. Service is for cart contents only, for both recycling and trash, meaning that all items must be inside the cart. If you need an additional cart, you must contact the Borough to do that, as they do the billing and will have to adjust your billing to account for the second cart.

When placing your carts out for service, make sure they are at least 3 feet apart and away from stationary objects, like mailboxes and cars, as we use automated trucks to service these carts. Hinges on the carts should be placed toward the house, so the part that opens is toward the road. This ensures the carts dump properly and get completely emptied.

Recycling: 1 65-gallon cart for recycling, cart contents only, or option for a smaller 35-gallon cart for recycling, cart contents only. Trash: 195-gallon cart for trash, cart contents only, or option for a smaller 35-gallon cart for trash, cart contents only.

Residents are permitted to set out 1 bulk item per week, as part of the contracted price. Residents must call 800.210.9675 to pre-schedule bulk items at least one day prior to service day.

 Microwaves, humidifiers, dishwashers, dryers, washers, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, water heaters, water softeners, vacuum cleaners, ceiling fans, box fans, barbecue grills, household furniture, kitchen tables, entertainment centers, sofas, couches, dressers, desks, bookcases, toys, picnic tables, ping pong tables (taken apart), swing sets (broken down), treadmills, patio sets, sofa sleepers, mattresses and box springs (must be wrapped in plastic bags, which can be purchased at any hardware store), speakers, sewing machines, sinks, bathtubs, carpet padding in 4 ft. length rolls, carpet in 4 ft. length rolls, toilets, bicycles, cabinets, doors. Anything over 4 ft. in length must be broken down and bundled and cannot weight over 75 pounds.
